**On Aug 29, we want to demonstrate
with you for solidarity and stand
together against discrimination.**

**The Saxony-Anhalt state elections will be held
on September 6th. For many among us, these
elections come along with the question of a
safe and self-determined life.**

**These elections are a threat – for migrants,
refugees, people of color, Jewish people,
queer people, black people, people with
disabilities, and all those who are not part of
the right-wing agenda.**

**These elections stir fears, the fear of being
discriminated, fear of fascist violence, fear of
policies that abridge our fundamental rights.
We are neighbours, colleagues, fellow
students and friends!**

The shift to the right has long begun.

It begins with people being played off against each other.

It begins with inhumane narratives being adopted by the far-right.

It begins with rights being distributed according to origin and passport.

Moderate parties have been adopting these narratives for years, implementing politics of exclusion and partition – legal, organized, legitimated.

Currently, the Common European Asylum System (CEAS) is being implemented. European borders, where thousands of people die on this very day, are being militarily enforced. Those who survive flight will be arrested in fenced camps, to be rejected and sent back in an accelerated procedure.

The individual right to asylum is thus abolished.

Libyan militia – co-funded by the EU – fire at sea rescuers and refugees. Instead of protecting people seeking shelter, flight and solidarity is being criminalized, and thousands are engulfed in misery of even death.

Moreover, the Federal Ministry of the Interior works together with the Taliban terrorists, with the aim of deporting people to Afghanistan, although this state is a catastrophe regarding security and human rights.

**Nobody leaves their home just for fun.
People seek refuge from war, prosecution,
poverty, hunger, and the consequences of
climate change.**

**These very people are being
discriminated, disenfranchised and
scapegoated.**

**We are not willing to
accept this injustice!**

**Migration is part of our society. Migrants
are part of this country, this state, this
society, and shape its everyday life on all
levels.**

**We say: you live here –
you belong here!**

It doesn't matter where you're from.

Let's not be divided!

**Let's meet, network, and stand
together for the values of a just,
diverse society of the many –
without:**

**racism,
antisemitism,
sexism,
ableism,
& queerphobia.**
